

JND521 – Tartan Style Centre Card - 4 July 2025 - by John Lockwood

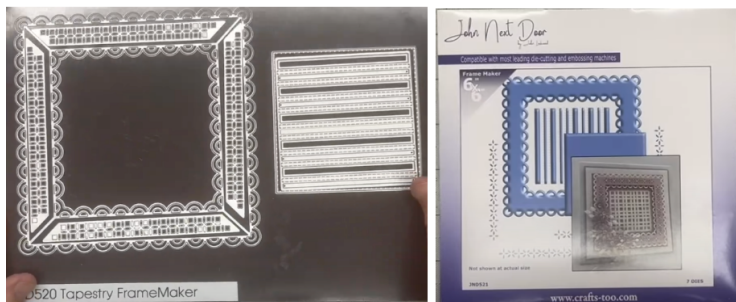


Instructions by June Smith

John has created a 'You Tube Video' dated 4th July 2025, using the new JND521 Square Scallop 6" x 6" FrameMaker Die set, where he demonstrates how to make a card. I would advise that you visit it as well as following these instructions.

Information:

If you exclude the flowers and leaves, it is only using 4 dies that make this entire card



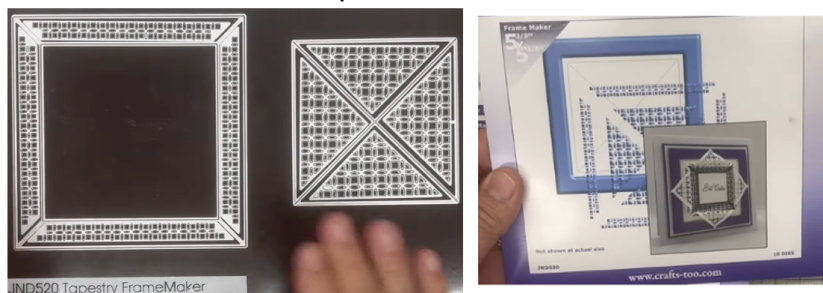
JND521 Square Scallop 6" x 6" FrameMaker Die Set (7)

Die 1: Outside Scalloped Frame

Dies 2-5: Detailed inside panels for the frame

Die 6: Dotted Square

Die 7: Stitched Insert Square



JND520 Tapestry 5" x 5" FrameMaker Die Set (10)

Die 1: Outside Frame 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ "

Dies 2 – 5: Scallop Insert dies which fit into die no 1

Die 3: Square and Cross in the middle

Dies 4-7 Decorative looped triangles

Materials

7" x 7" White Top Folding Card Blank

JND521 Square Scallop 6" x 6" FrameMaker Die (7)

JND520 Tapestry 5" x 5" FrameMaker Die (10)

CTJJ60 Simple Poppies Stamps

CT902 Precision Stamp Block

JND501 Stitched Dogwood

JND502 Stitched Shadow Leaves (6)

Essential Coconut White Card

Canvas Card – Dark Grey, Soft Pink,

Versafine Smokey Grey Ink Pad

A4 Die Cutting Machine

Glue Gel with a cocktail stick

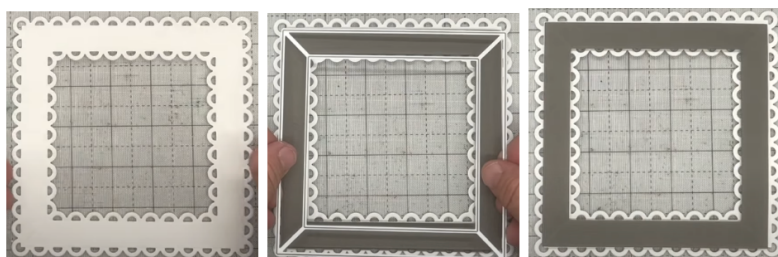
Glue Glaze

2mm Foam Tape

Craft Kit

Method:

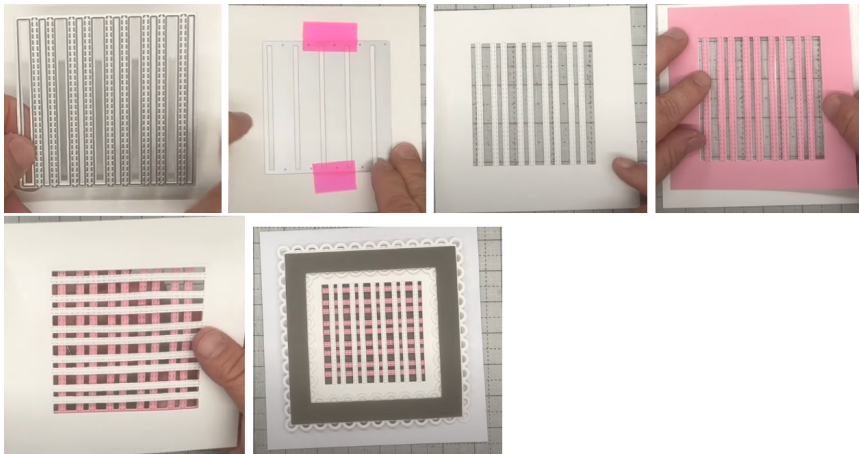
- Take a piece of Coconut white card and tape down die no 1 from the JND521 Square Scallop 6" x 6" FrameMaker set and run through your die cutting machine. Also cut die no 1 from the JND520 Tapestry 5" x 5" FrameMaker set from the dark grey canvas card. Add foam tape onto the back of the grey and add onto the white frame.



- We now want to make a centre for the card, so take another piece of coconut white card cut to 5" x 5", then take die no 7 from JND521 Square Scallop set and add this into the centre of the square. Tape it down well and run through your die cutting machine. Keep all the fall away pieces, if not for this card then for another.
- Cut the same die out of a piece of the soft pink card. Then add foam tape onto the back of the white piece, remove the yellow backing and rotate it and place onto the pink lining up the top left and bottom right corner. Turn the card over and again add foam tape around the outside, remove the yellow backing and add this onto a square of the same grey card and stick it down. We then have our centre. If you position the frame over it you can see that

we have that beautiful tartan pattern. Add foam tape onto the back, remove the yellow backing and adhere onto the front of the card.

- Turn the piece over and add wet glue onto it and add this straight onto a 7" x 7" top folding card blank.



- We now need to add a centre panel using the PCD204 Square dies (dies 25 & 26), cut yourself a 2" soft pink square and a 1 3/4" square which has already been stamped with the sentiment. Add foam tape onto the back, remove the yellow backing and adhere onto the middle of your card.



- John has already pre-cut and made up some of the Stitched Dogwood and Stitched Shadow Leaves from the same colours as the card also some of the Stitched Vine Leaves. Some of the flowers have a centre of a corresponding colour and some have a clear centre gem in the middle. I have added some pictures below of the different stages. John has used wet glue onto the back of the leaves and Glue Gel with a cocktail stick to add in the flowers.





- You can of course decorate your card using any of the flowers and leaves from any of the dies that John has produced.



Your creation is now complete. I hope you have enjoyed these instructions.
