

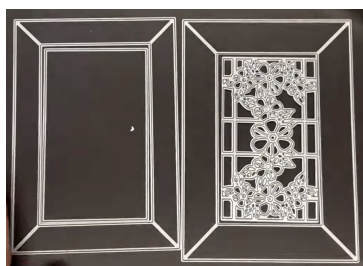
JND525 Stain Glass Window Panel Card - by John Lockwood

John has created a 'You Tube Video' dated 7 September 2025, using the new JND525 Janes Panel Die set, which is designed to fit our 5" x 7" FrameMaker to demonstrate how to make a card. I would advise that you visit it as well as following these instructions.

Information:



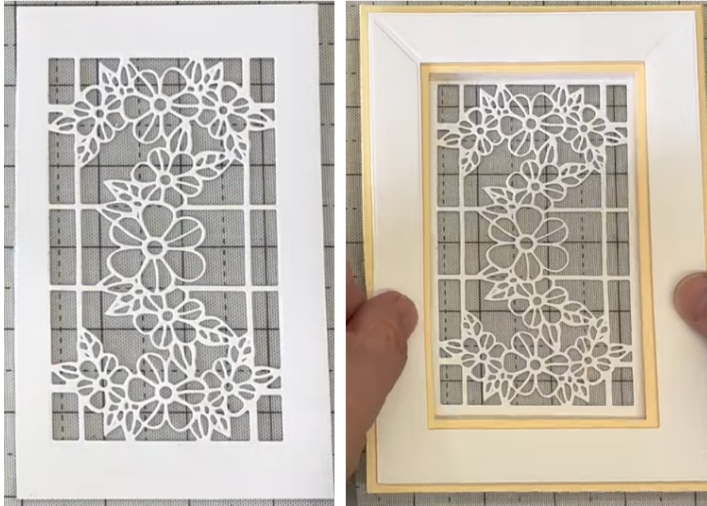
The frame can be used with the Christmas FrameMaker's which have a similar size, and the Janes Panel has a separate outside cutting die so that it can be used on its own, or it can be used with bigger frames and things like that. We will be using Alcohol Markers; any make will do as long as they colour onto Acetate.

Materials

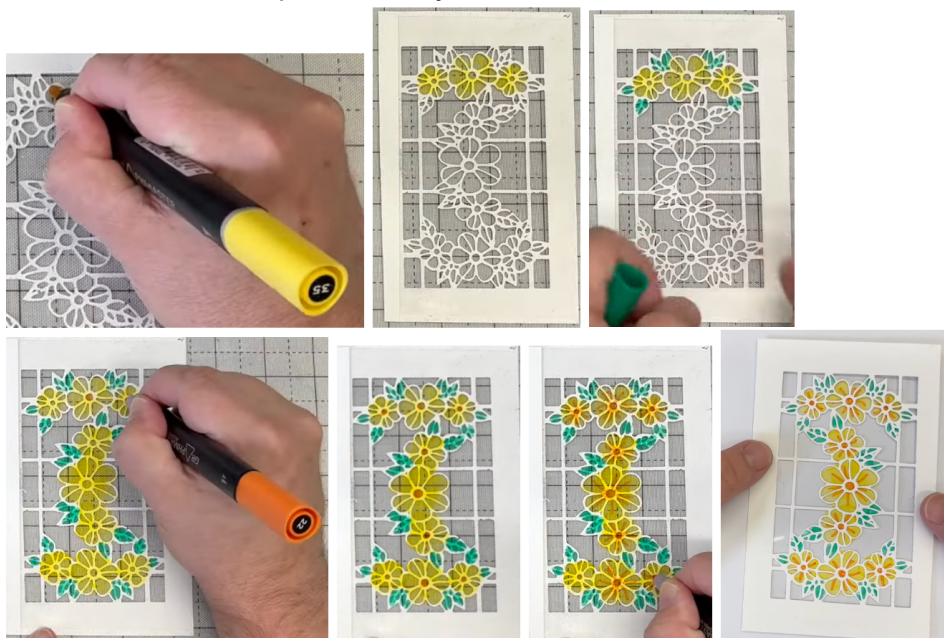
6" x 8" Top Folding Card Blank
JND525 Janes Panel Die (2)
FrameMaker dies to make a 5" x 7" frame
Alcohol Markers – Yellow, Green & Orange
Essential Coconut White Card
Canvas card – Pale Yellow
Acetate
Die Cutting Machine
CAT100 - CA Dew Drops - Rainbow
2mm Foam Tape
Craft Kit

Method:

- Cut a piece of Coconut White card to $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " tape down the inside panel die and run through your die cutting machine. As you can see this fits nicely behind our frame. Adhere a piece of acetate cut to $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " onto the back of the panel.



- Lay the panel face down onto your mat, as we now want to colour our flowers so bring in your Yellow marker and colour in all of the flowers. Then switch over to a Green marker and colour in all of the leaves. Then bring in your Orange marker and colour in the centre of each flower. Then add a few strips of the orange onto each of the petals to give a bit of dimension. When you then turn the piece over you can see how beautiful it looks.



- Take a piece of double sided adhesive, remove the white layer and add onto a piece of white card, then remove the other side which is very sticky. Bring in your coloured dew drops and sprinkle them randomly onto the sticky card. Then hold the coloured frame over the top and you can see how stunning this looks. To adhere these together we will use blue powertape which is very

strong, and add this all the way around the outside, remove the blue covering and add straight onto your dew drop panel, press down firmly all the way around.



- John has already made a frame using the 5" x 7" FrameMaker dies, in a pale yellow canvas card and coconut white card. Add foam tape onto the back and adhere over the front of your card.
- Turn it over and add wet glue onto the back and add this onto a larger 6" x 8" top folding white card blank.



Your creation is now complete. I hope you have enjoyed these instructions.
