

## JND584 & JND585 – Peacock Flower Card in Pink - by John Lockwood



Instructions by June Smith

John has created a 'You Tube Video' dated 31st March 2026, using JND584 Peacock Flower die set & JND585 Exotic Ferns die, where he demonstrates how to make this beautiful card above, you can make so many different colours of flowers and with all the different swirls. I would advise that you visit it as well as following these instructions.

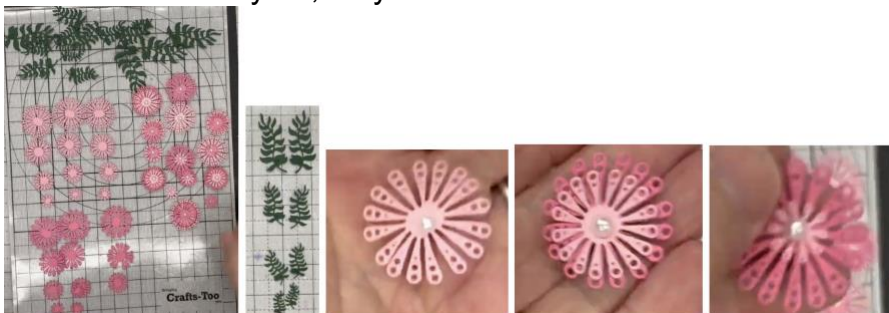
### Materials:

- 6" x 8" Top Folding Card Blank
- JND584 Peacock Flower die set
- JND585 Exotic Ferns Die
- JND562 Round Square FrameMaker Die (16)
- CA Essential White Card
- Canvas Co-ordinations Soft Pinks Card – 2 different shades of Pinks
- Canvas Co-ordinations Summer Greens Card – Dark Green
- JND486 Moroccan Tile 3D Embossing Folder & 2 Matching Stencils
- White Stick on Pearls
- CAT321 Glue Gel

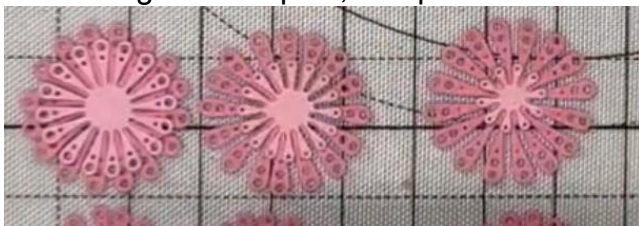
## Die Cutting Machine Craft Kit

### Method:

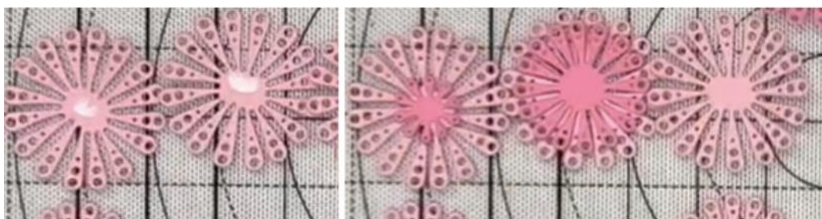
- We are going to concentrate first by cutting and making up the actual Peacock Flowers. John has already cut out the Peacock Flowers in a light pink and a bright pink from the Canvas Card. The flowers on the right hand side have already been put together, you can see below John is holding one of the Peacock Flowers in the palm of his hand and with the tiny graduated holes in the flower you can see where the Peacock die gets its name from, there is also a white pearl in the middle, then he is holding up a flower made up with the 2 different colours of the Soft Pinks canvas card, and another with 3 different layers, they all look so beautiful.



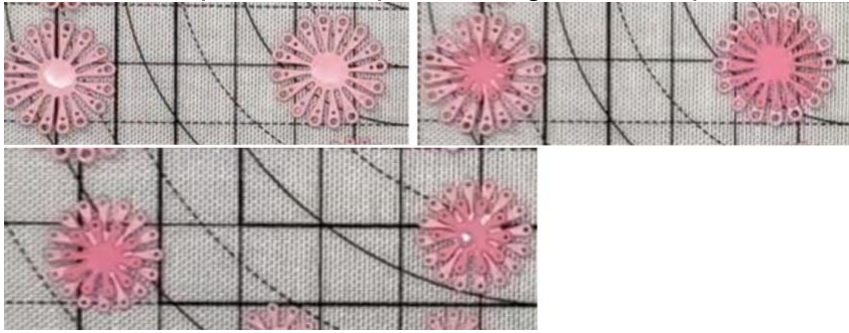
- Then we have the Exotic Ferns from the Summer Greens pack in a dark green card, you get a left and a right in 4 different sizes so 8 in total, it is easier to place these in order on your mat before you begin to put everything together.
- To make the Flowers up (this is entirely up to you how you layer up your flowers, but this is how John is doing them). We are using Glue Glaze as it is the easiest way to do it, so starting with the 3 larger darker pink add a dab of glue glaze into the centre of each, then using your 4-in-1 tool pick-up one each of the soft pink size flowers and place one each into the centre of the large darker pink, see photo below.



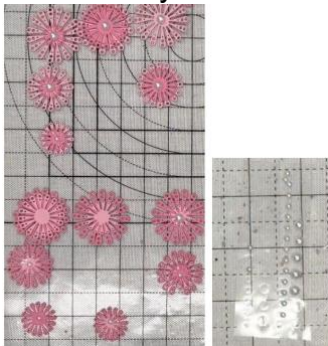
- Then add glue glaze into the centre of 2 of the large Soft Pink flower and add a small darker flower into one, a medium darker pink into the next one and for the last one we will leave that as it is.



- Then add glue glaze into the centre of the medium lighter pink and add a darker pink, then repeat adding a smaller pink in the next one.



- Carry on in the way until you have made up your flowers, then add your White Stick on pearls into the centre, making sure that the size of pearls are realistic, so you don't want a great big pearl onto a small flower. Or you could use your Rainbow Dew Drops if you prefer.



- Take a 6" x 8" Top Folding Card Blank and mat and layer a Green, Dark Pink, Coconut White card layer and finally a Coconut White card which has been embossed with one of John's embossing folders.
- Then from the JND562 Round Square FrameMaker Die cut the swirly die out of Coconut White card and add this onto a piece of the lighter Pink card which has been cut from another die in the set. Add 3 pieces of foam tape onto the back, remove the yellow backing and add this onto the top of your card. Then repeat to cut another in the same colours, add foam on the back, remove the yellow backing and add that onto the bottom edge of the card. Then this time we are going to cut out a set from the darker pink card set out and added a white die cut of the swirly pattern onto the top, again add 3 pieces of foam tape onto the back, remove the yellow backing and add this piece horizontally onto the centre of your card.



- John has then cut from the medium pink card another die from this set or it may be a similar one and also cut the next size down from Coconut white card, he has then added a stamped verse 'May Your Birthday be a Special Celebration and a Wonderful day to Remember, using the Smokey Ink Pad,

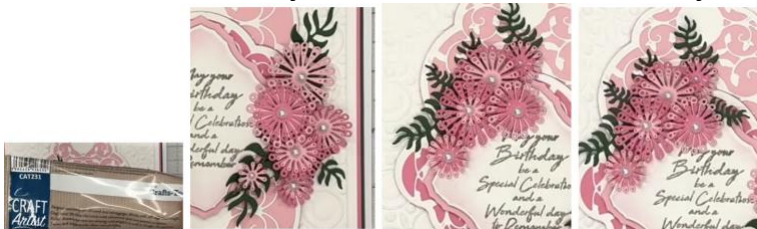
he has then layered these 2 up and added foam tape onto the back remove the backing and add this straight onto the front of the card.



- We can now begin to add our leaves, using glue glaze onto the back of the leaves and 3 different sizes on each side of the sentiment panel, see photos below.



- When it comes to adding our flowers, we will use CA 3DGlue Gel with a cocktail stick, which is the best way to add our flowers. Add a little blob of the gel onto the back of your flowers and add these onto the front of the card.
- Add a mix of sizes, shapes and colours of your flowers onto the right hand side onto the leaves, so you have 6 in total, then on the left hand side repeat adding 4 flowers, then for the 5th flower which is a smaller flower we will add one of the small left over leaves onto the back then place this at the top of the card and finally take the other small leaf and add a tiny bit of gel onto the back and tuck that just behind the flower that is just above the stamped verse.



Your creation is now complete. I hope you have enjoyed these instructions.
