

Framed Leaves Card with JND598 Tiarella FrameMaker & JND597 Viola Dies - by John Lockwood



Instructions by June Smith

John has created a 'You Tube Video' dated 15th May 2026, using the JND598 Tiarella FrameMaker dies, and the outside cutting frame from JND597 Viola FrameMaker dies where he demonstrates how to make this beautiful card above. We will be using the Canvas Co-ordination Card though out the card. I would advise that you visit it as well as following these instructions.

Die 1: - 4³/₄" x 6³/₄" Stitched Rectangle FrameMaker

Dies 2 & 3: - 6" Vertical Ribbon Strips

Dies 4 & 5: - 4" Vertical Ribbon Strips

Die 6: 3' x 5" Plain Rectangle

Die 7: 2³/₄" x 4³/₄" Outer Leaf Pattern

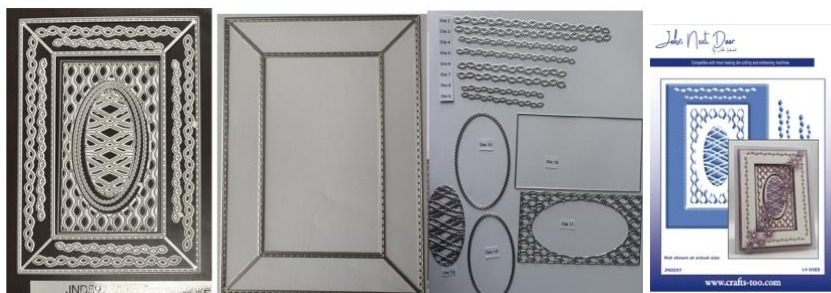
Die 8: 3⁵/₈" x 2" Oval

Die 9: 3¹/₂" x 1⁷/₈" Inner Leaf Pattern

Die 10: Outer Leaf

Die 11: Inner Leaf Pattern

JND597 Viola FrameMaker



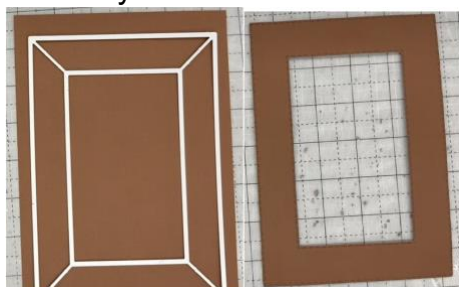
- Die 1: - 5" x 7" FrameMaker Stitched Rectangle
- Dies 2-3: Left & Right Vertical 6" Long Leaf Strips
- Dies 4-5 Left & Right 3" Short Horizontal Leaf Strips
- Dies 6 -7 Top & Bottom Vertical 4" Shorter Leaf Strips
- Dies 8-9: Top & Bottom Vertical 3" Shorter Leaf Strips
- Die 10: 2¾" x 4¾" Plain Rectangle
- Die 11: Rectangle Leaf Pattern with Oval cut out from the centre
- Die 12: 3½" Double Stitched Oval
- Die 13: 3¼" Double Stitched Inner Oval
- Die 14: Crisscross Pattern Die

Materials:

- 6" x 8" Top Folding Card Blank
- JND591 Skeleton Leaves
- JND598 Tiarella FrameMaker (9)
- JND597 Viola FrameMaker (14)
- Canvas Co-ordination Card – Burgundy & Winter Browns,
- 3M Permanent Spray Adhesive
- Die Cutting Machine
- Craft Kit

Method:

- Take the Viola Frame outside cutting die and tape this down onto a piece of the Ginger card then run this through your die cutting machine, we don't need to use anymore of the Viola dies so you can put them away in your storage system.



- Next we want to bring in Die 1: 4¾" x 6¾" Stitched Rectangle FrameMaker and tape this down onto a piece of the Burgundy card and run that through your die cutting machine. As you can see on the close up below it has that wonderful stitched detail on the inside and outside of the die. Add foam tape onto the back, reveal the tape and add this onto the Ginger frame. This gives

a perfect $\frac{1}{8}$ " border around the inside and outside of the frame, pop this to one side for now.



- Cut a piece of the lighter brown Canvas Co-ordinations card to just short of $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $6\frac{3}{4}$ " and tape down die no: 7: which is the $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ " Outer Leaf Pattern, then run this through your die cutting machine. Poke out all the waste pieces and add some of the new CA foam tape around the outside, reveal the tape and add the lighter next shade down of the Winter Browns card onto the front. When you then turn this over you can see the beautiful shadowing of the colours on the card.



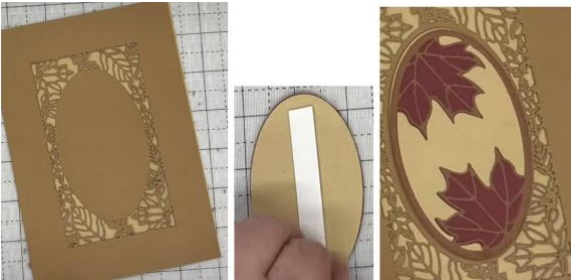
- Now we can remove the frame as we want to build out the central section of the design, this is a little bit more complicated so John will show us what to do. He has cut out pieces of the Burgundy, Ginger and light brown card. Then taken a long piece of removable tape and pick up Die 8 which is the $3\frac{5}{8}$ " x 2" Oval then hover this over Die 9 the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " Inner Leaf Pattern and press down on the tape and add onto the Ginger card. We then want to take the Burgundy piece and cut this into 2 same size pieces, then tape down Die no: 10 Solid Maple leaf, and run both of these through your die cutting machine.



- Take the outer die and for speed John is using his spray box and adding 3M Permanent Spray Adhesive onto the back of the Oval Leaf, then take one of the solid Leaves and add this onto the sticky bottom leaf, then add the other one onto the sticky top leaf. Turn the piece over and with your scissors trim off the overhanging part of the 2 leaves, then add wet glue onto the back of the leaves and add this onto the lighter oval.



- Bring back in our central section and add a strip of the foam tape onto the back of the oval, reveal the tape and add onto the centre of your card.



- Bring back in the Frame, reveal the foam tape and add this onto the card.



- John has created a card blank at 6" x 8" and matted some of that beautiful Ginger colour onto it. Then turn the main piece over and add wet glue around the outsides and add this onto our card base.



- We now just need to decorate this; John has already cut the solid and outside leaves in the 3 colours used on our card. Again, he is bringing in the spray box and add the 3 outline leaves face down on the box, added spray glue onto them and then mix the colours around so you end up with the 3 leaves below. Then fold the leaves down the middle a little bit to shape them.



- When we then add these onto the front of the card we will use the CA 3D Glue Gel and a cocktail stick and add these onto the front of your card.



Your creation is now complete. I hope you have enjoyed these instructions.
